With respect to the above subject the GDR EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY is pleased to announce the following policy for its students academic upliftment and motivation in all its constituent colleges with immediate effect...

- 1. Two best projects in a department will get 50% Reimbursement of the cost incurred in the project subject to maximum Rs. 5000/- per project. The students will have to make an application to the concerned HOD through their respective Guides, attaching the original and genuine bills. It shall be the responsibility of the concerned Guide and HOD to check the genuineness. The concerned HOD will be the sanctioning authority who will keep a record of all the sanctions. This limit is per year per department.
- 2. For attending State / National level Competitions, the Reimbursement shall be 50% of the Registration fee and 50% of Travelling expenses. Other modalities will be the same as in point number 1 above. For International level competitions, the decision will be taken on case to case basis by the management.
- 3. For publication of Papers in Conferences / Seminars / Journals, Obtaining Patents, etc. the policy shall be the same as mentioned in the New Research Policy of Rungta Group, Ref.: SRGI/RP/2021/585 dated 01/10/21.
